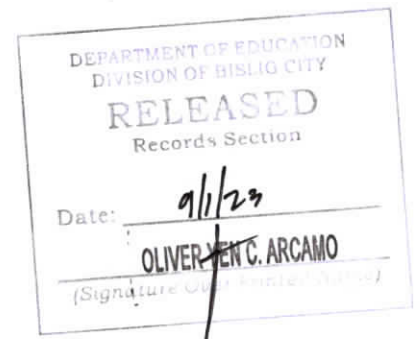

**INVITATION TO THE WORLD FOOD DAY REGIONAL ON THE SPOT

1. As per Regional Memorandum No. 0631, s. 2023, re: INVITATION TO THE WORLD FOOD DAY REGIONAL ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST, sponsored by the Department of Agriculture – Field Office 13, which will happen on September 7, 2023, 8am. Venue to be announced. In line with this issuance, and to represent the Division to this Regional Contest, the Division will hold a **Division Level Poster Making Contest** this coming **September 5, 2023, Tuesday** at the **Schools Governance and Operations Division – Division**
2. The contest is **open to all Grades V to VI Elementary learners** enrolled in **any public and private schools**, with **only one (1) entry per school**. There will be **NO ON THE SPOT Poster Making Contest**. Meanwhile, to not disrupt classes, the School Head shall submit the school's final entry to the SGOD – Division Office from 8am to 12 noon on September 5, Tuesday. The entry must be based on the theme **“Water is life, water is food. Leave no one behind”** drawn on a 20” x 30” illustration board. Any entry submitted beyond the time stated will no longer be accepted.
3. Please take note that the conduct of this division level contest is to serve as a pre-qualifying undertaking. So, the division winners will only receive a Certificate when determined and declared.
4. Judging of entries will happen in the afternoon of the same date. Top 3 winners will be proclaimed and announced right after. However, only the Top 1 and Top 2 will advance and represent the division to the regional level contest.

The winning poster will then be the region's official entry to the national level of the contest.

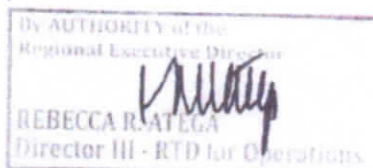

## Regional On the Spot Poster Making Contest Guidelines

The following is the set of guidelines for the On the Spot Poster Making Contest:

### I. General Provisions

The following are the general provisions for the On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest:

1. The contest is open to all Grades V to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private schools nationwide. Previous national winners of this contest are disqualified to join.
2. Pupils shall be allowed to have one (1) coach or one (1) guardian.
3. The Regional Poster Making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot on September 7, 2023. (Schools Division/District level of the contest may be conducted provided that expenses to be incurred shall be shouldered by the DepEd.)
4. Contestants of the regional contest are not allowed to bring their own materials. Materials to be used for the Regional Poster Making Contest shall be limited to an illustration board (20" x 30"), oil pastel and pentel pen to be provided by the Contest Committee during the regional contest.
5. The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written on a separate sheet of paper, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
6. Only one (1) entry shall be endorsed by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee as official entry to the National level.
7. The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven to commit any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating), the title and the prize shall be withdrawn.
8. The Regional Top Three winners will receive a cash prize of P5,000, P4,000 and P3,000 respectively as well as medal, and certificate of recognition. Non-winners will receive a consolation prize of P1,000 each and certificate of participation.
9. All entries shall become the property of the DA and FAO.

### II. Criteria for Judging:

The Board of Judges (BOJ) shall preside the adjudication of entries based on the following criteria:

a. Originality -----	30%
b. Creativity -----	30%
c. Visual Impact -----	20%
d. Relevance to the theme -----	20%
Total -----	100%
